## STATUS

Summer visitor.

#### ABUNDANCE

Rare. Probably no more than 8-10 birds.

#### **HABITAT**

Pseudosteppe scenery of pastureland, broom scrub and open Holm-Oak woods.

#### **SEASONAL BEHAVIOUR**

The handful of birds breeding in Sierra Morena arrive in late spring and leave at the end of summer.

## DISTRIBUTION

One small breeding colony only in northern Sierra Morena Sevillana.

#### COMMENTS

The Black-Bellied Sandgrouse breeding here are probably an overspill from the much bigger population in neighbouring southern Badajoz.
