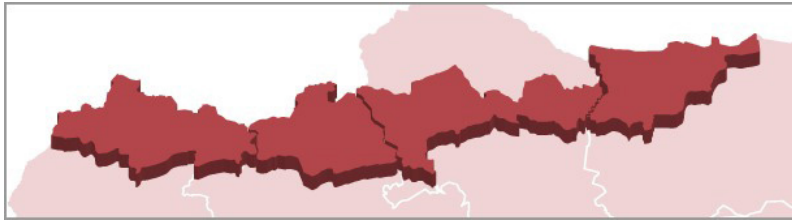


Cuckoo

Takes to a wide variety of woodland. Found in dense woods (Cork-Oak woods and Portuguese-Oak woods, Sweet-Chestnut woods, pinewoods, Pyrenean-Oak woods, etc), patches of Mediterranean scrub, *dehesas*, riverside thickets and copses, *campiña* with hedges, etc.
