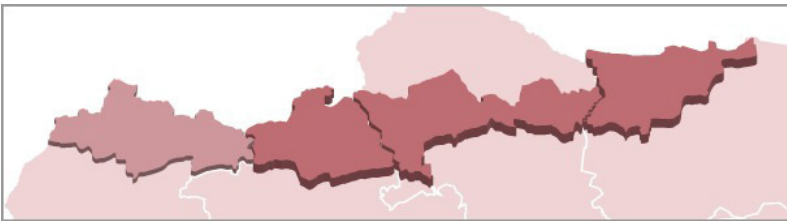


Gadwall

SEASONAL BEHAVIOUR

Most likely to be seen from November to March.

DISTRIBUTION

Habitual on some stretches of the Guadalquivir like El Salto or Marmolejo Reservoir as well as Rincón del Jándula and José Torán Reservoir; probably breeds in all these sites. It sometimes drops into other areas of open water, especially in winter.
