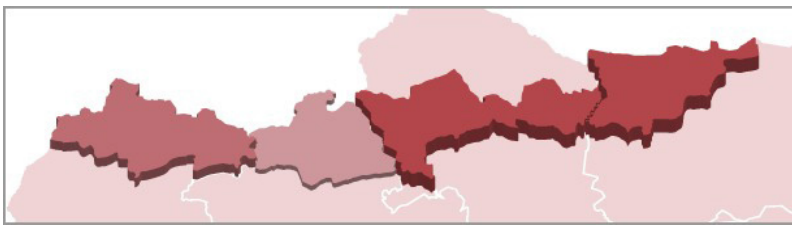


# Goshawk

### SEASONAL BEHAVIOUR

Year round presence.

### DISTRIBUTION

Present in the four provinces but very scarce in Seville, uncommon in Huelva and common in Córdoba and Jaén, with particularly high numbers in some spots (pinewoods of Villaviciosa de Córdoba, northern Sierra de Hornachuelos and Despeñaperros).

### COMMENTS

At the end of the breeding season young birds are sometimes seen in unusual habitat like olive groves and *campiña*.
