### SEASONAL BEHAVIOUR

Seen above all from November to March.

### DISTRIBUTION

On passage turns up in suitable habitat of all four provinces. Regular wintering areas include Llanos de Guadalcanal and the *campiña* of Villanueva de la Reina; less frequently seen in Viar valley.
