












STATUS

HABITAT

Cropland in the campiña, dehesas and upland livestock pastures.

SEASONAL BEHAVIOUR

Likeliest to be seen from October to March.

DISTRIBUTION

Might be found in any suitable habitat throughout the region though in general it is scarce and tricky to see.

COMMENTS

Joins flocks of the much more abundant Spotless Starling, which it greatly resembles in winter plumage.
