SEASONAL BEHAVIOUR

Seen all year in its breeding areas.

DISTRIBUTION

The lion's share of the population lives in Jaén and Córdoba, in olive groves down in the campiña and in foothills between Montoro and La Carolina, always in low numbers. A scattered distribution elsewhere in oneoff sites like Cañaveral de León, some dehesas of Hornachuelos and old orchards of Cazalla de la Sierra.

COMMENTS

A very scarce species that is little known and studied in Sierra Morena. Sometimes joins flocks of other sparrow species.
