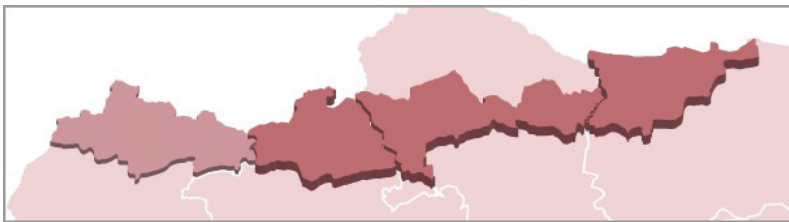


Yellow Wagtail

SEASONAL BEHAVIOUR

Spring passage takes place from March to May, and post-breeding mainly in August and September. Between these dates there are a few breeding birds.

DISTRIBUTION

On passage may be seen in suitable areas of any district. As a breeder confined to farmland around La Puebla de los Infantes in Seville, Guadalquivir valley in Hornachuelos and Montoro, and cropland to the south of Andújar and Marmolejo.
